

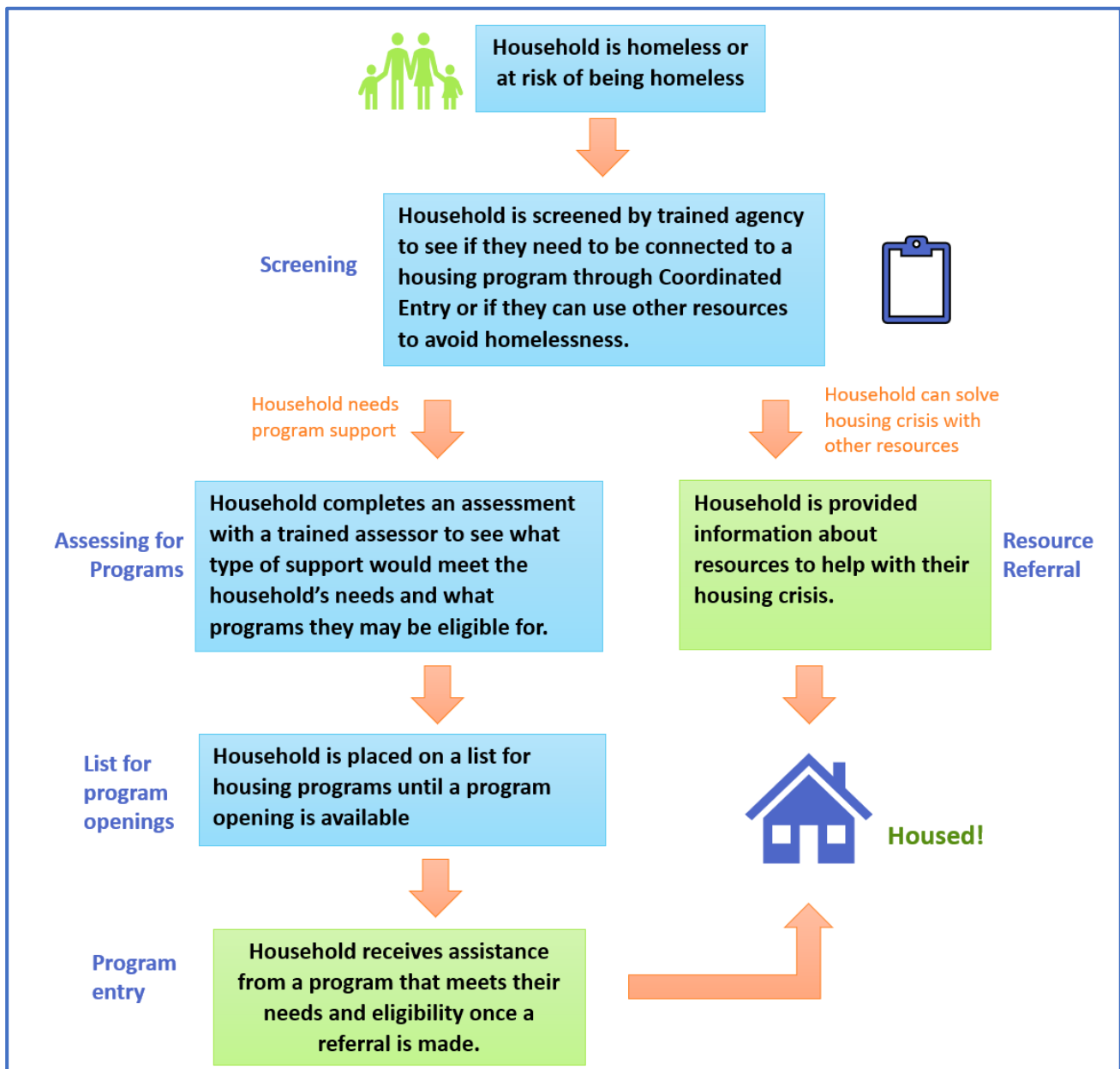
COORDINATED ENTRY 101

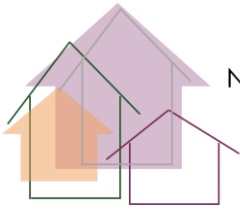
WHAT IS COORDINATED ENTRY?

Coordinated Entry is a central access point to homeless programs and resources across the region. People experiencing homelessness or at risk of being homeless can complete one assessment that shows their needs and what programs they might be eligible for. They are placed on a shared list and are connected to the program that meets their needs when an opening is available.

Coordinated Entry prioritizes people experiencing homelessness with the highest needs to break down barriers to housing.
