

NE MN Continuum of Care 2024 Point-in-Time Count Results by County

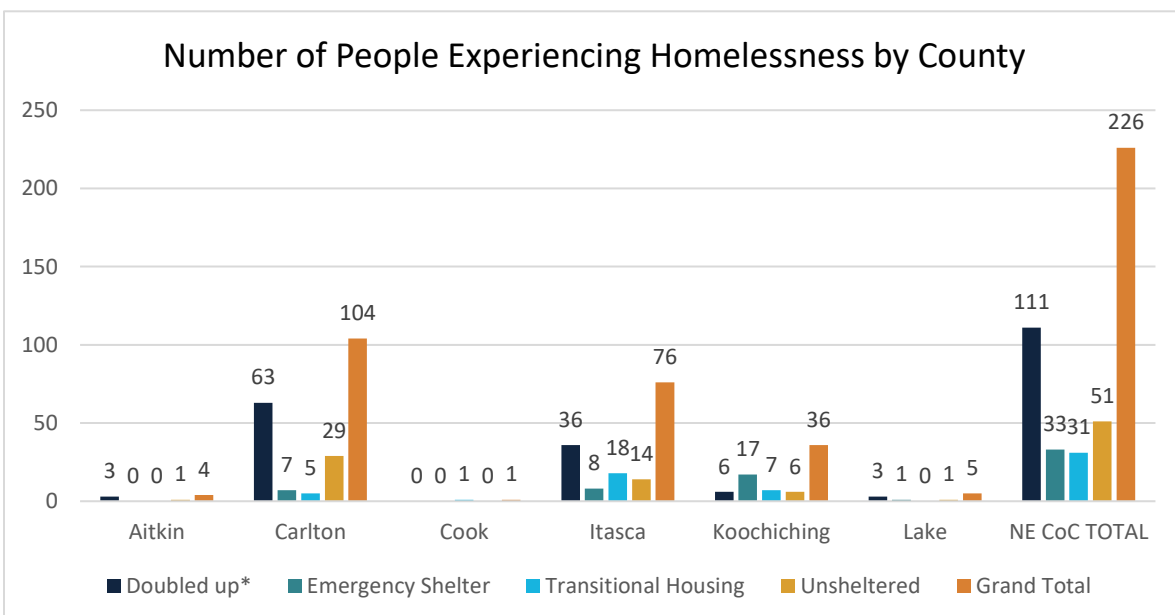
Background:

This document summarizes the results of the 2024 Point-in-Time (PIT) Count for the Northeast Minnesota Continuum of Care (NE CoC). The PIT Count is a one-night snapshot of people experiencing homelessness in our region, which includes Aitkin, Carlton, Cook, Itasca, Koochiching, and Lake Counties. In 2024, the PIT Count was held on January 24, 2024.

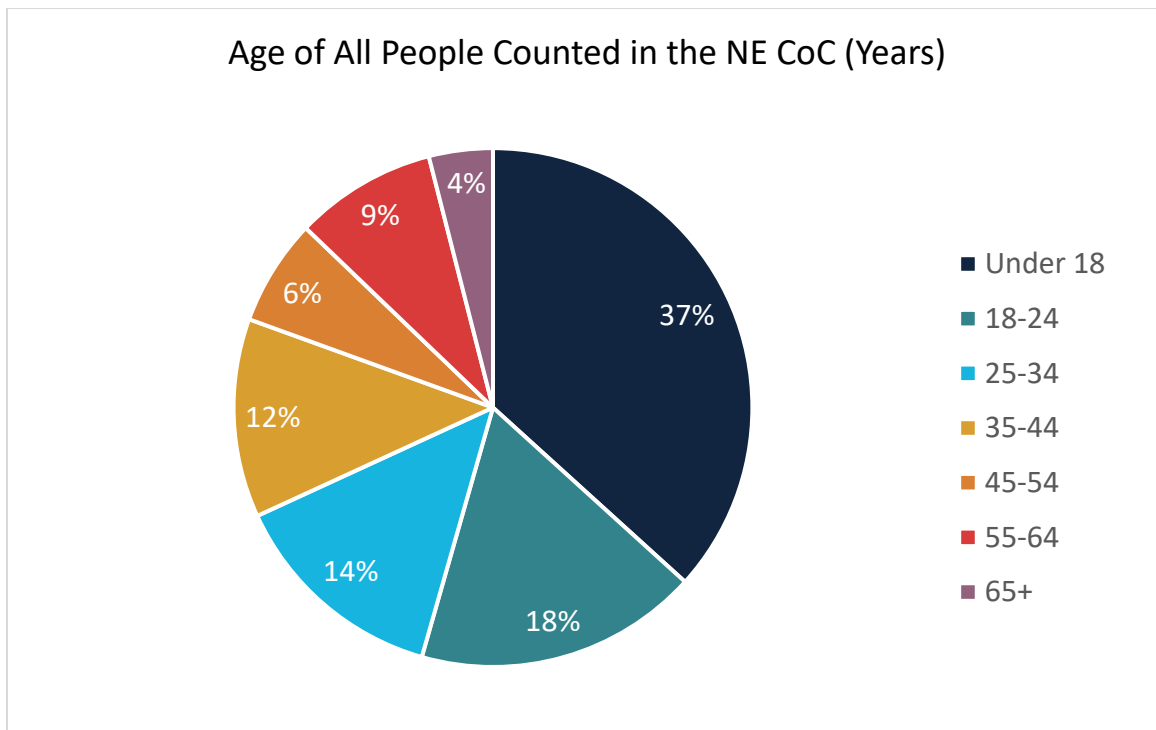

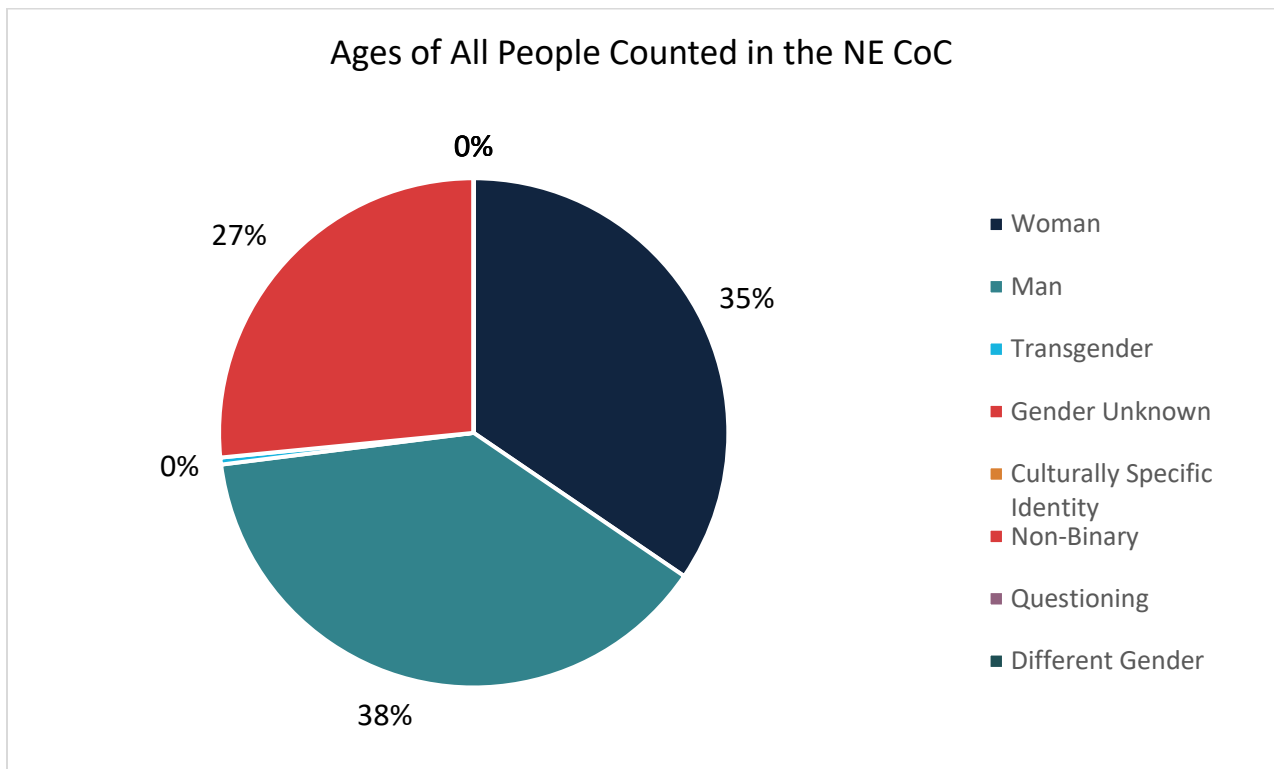
